Dr Michael Rezak, is a double fellowship trained movement disorders neurologist with Ascension Saint Alexius Hospital in Hoffman Estates, IL. Prior to joining Ascension Saint Alexius Hospital, Dr Rezak was the head of the Northwestern Movement Disorders Neurology Group in Winfield, IL followed by a 2 year stint at Vassar Brother Medical Center in Poughkeepsie, NY. He has published many scientific papers and has an extensive clinical trial background.

Nourianz (Istradefylline)


Nourianz was approved in the United States at the end of 2019 and has been approved in Japan for almost 10 years. Between the US and Japan over 100,000 Parkinson's patients have been prescribed the medication, it is marketed in the United States by Kyowa Kirin. Nourianz is approved as an adjunctive (add-on) medication to patients currently on Carbidopa/Levodopa who are experiencing "off episodes". It is the first Adenosine blocker approved in the United States and does not work on Dopamine. It is dosed once a day, with/without food, anytime of the day and can be added to any of the current Parkinson's medications. Nourianz is available in 20mg and 40mg tablets and is currently the #1 branded add-on agent in the United States.
